

- Grundtvig Partnership LLLE (Learning Later Life Europe) which aims to investigate areas of importance for learning activities in later life, and in which older people are engaged, such as handcrafts, culture, arts.
- Grundtvig Multilateral MATURE (Making Adult Education Useful, Relevant and Engaging) that will develop units of training for teachers to support them to deliver effective and motivating teaching for disaffected and disadvantaged learners.
